

Long Questions

1. Importance of Ruku and Sujud:

They are essential parts of Salah. Without them, Salah is incomplete. The Prophet said the worst stealing is stealing from Salah, which means not doing Ruku and Sujud properly.

2. How Sujud should be performed:

Sujud must be done on seven bones – forehead, both hands, both knees, and toes of both feet. The elbows must be raised and not touch the ground. Qur'an should not be recited, but du'a can be made.

3. Meaning of Qiyam and Julus:

Qiyam means standing straight, not bending the back. It is done at the start of Salah and after Ruku. Julus means sitting, performed between the two Sujud and during Tashahhud.

4. Hadith about the man who prayed hurriedly:

A man prayed in Masjid-un-Nabawi but did not perform Ruku and Sujud properly. The Prophet told him to repeat the prayer, saying, "Go and offer Salah, for you have not offered it."

5. Why Salah is a Pillar and hallmark:

Salah is one of the Five Pillars of Islam. It is the sign of a true Muslim. A Muslim is recognized by the way he performs Salah, which shows obedience, discipline, and closeness to Allah.
