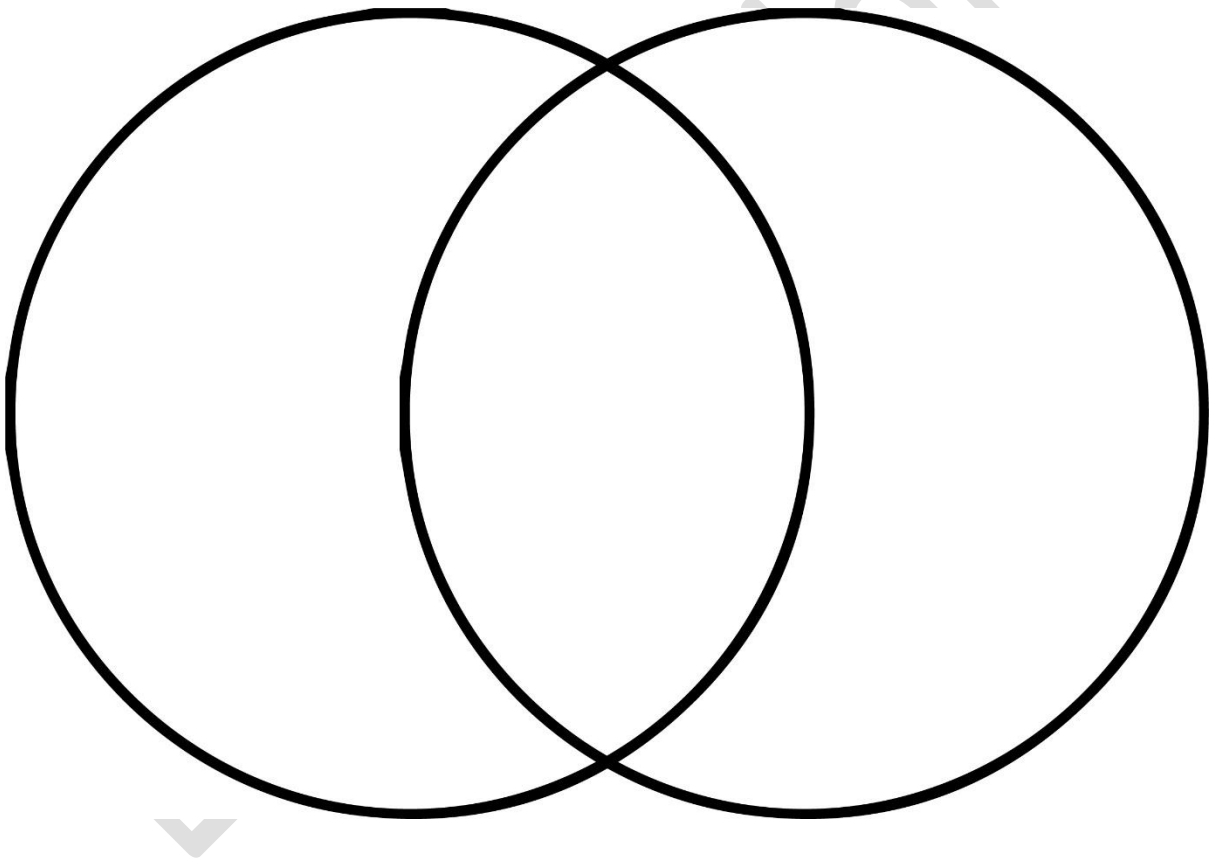

Venn Diagram

Angels: Created from light, never disobey Allah, no gender, do not eat/drink/sleep, carry out duties, record deeds, bring revelation.

Humans: Created from clay, can make mistakes, male/female, eat/drink/sleep, have free will.

Similarities: Both are Allah's creation, both worship Allah, both have responsibilities.

 - Israfil: will blow trumpet on Last Day
 - Izra'il: takes souls at death
3. **Most significant duty:** Bringing Divine Revelation, ensures Allah's guidance reaches Prophets and people.
4. **Functions:** Recording deeds, comforting pious, punishing nations, strengthening Prophets, guarding humans, attending Qur'an gatherings, bringing rain, etc. (at least six required).
5. **Faith benefits:** Reminds Muslims that deeds are recorded, increases taqwa, strengthens belief in unseen, motivates obedience, builds trust in Allah's system.
